

General Information: The Illinois State Assembly has created state scholarships to support participation in Reserve Officers Training Corps, in order to provide officers for the Armed Forces of the United States of America.

Eligibility: Recipients must be:

1. Illinois State Resident
2. Enrolled in NROTC
3. Full Time Student
4. Eligible for Financial Aid

Availability: 10 scholarships will be awarded to each class (Fr, So, Jr, Sr) every semester. Any scholarships not utilized by the assigned class will be reallocated to other classes, which have eligible applicants.

Selection: Scholarships will be awarded to applicants based on NROTC class standing which is comprised of academic performance (50%), leadership aptitude (35%), and Physical Fitness Assessment (PFA) score (15%). Incoming new students will be awarded scholarships based on GPA, college entrance exam scores (SAT/ACT), and extra-curricular activity participation.

Applications must be submitted during the first 2 weeks of each semester (Fall, Spring, Summer) which benefits are being requested.

New Student Applications must be submitted along with the following requirements:

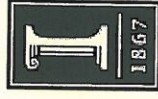
1. Essay
2. College Program Questionnaire
3. High School Transcript
4. Certified Certificate of Live Birth or Naturalization Certificate
5. Physical Fitness Participation Form
6. College Entrance Test Scores
7. OPMIS Information Form

Recipients will receive benefits as long as they apply, complete an annual exam, remain competitive and eligible. The Professor of Naval Science may revoke the scholarship if the student participates in misconduct, fails to remain eligible for financial aid or fails to meet NROTC program requirements.
